

## Spring Budget Allocations Meeting, February 10, 2012

- \$100 per group for food.
  - Within \$100: includes food in care packages for CPILO. Also includes buying candy for kids in Constitution in the Classroom, UNC Street Law, etc.
- \$25 per speaker. \$25 for food, \$25 for honorarium.
  - UNC Law Professor compensation for speaking: \$10 honorarium (same \$25 for food).
  - *To approve food/honorarium for speaker:* need to know **who** speaker is. **Approximate date** suffices.
- Printing and publicity funding limit: discretionary by event. (Case by case)
- Generally do not pay/compensate for travel expenses.
- Will NOT compensate or pay for parking. But paying to reserve law school parking lot is okay.
- Journals: not funding food for journal events. But willing to approve materials (printing, orientation supplies, etc.)
