 - Motion to table discussion on Symposium equipment, etc. - approved.
 - Strike \$500 from basket
 - Motion: 3 abstention/ all others—approved
 - Motion to strike End of year award:\$150—approved
 - Motion \$150 for professional
 - Dues and Fees \$30
 - Rental \$220
 - Motion to give: \$150 professional fees
 - Dues and \$30

 - Motion from \$160 to \$80
- Motion to approve \$320:
 - 1 abstention, all others in favor
 - Passed

Hispanic/Latino Law Student Association

- Requested for 3 events:

 - Total requested \$455
- SBA responds:

 - Motion to strike books

- Motion to approve \$295:
 - One abstention – all others in favor
 - Passed

ACLU

- Requested:
 - \$365 for food
 - \$50 for honorarium
 - This is for a retroactive event that occurred last semester
- SBA responds:
 - Try to have another fundraiser event
- Motion to approve \$150:
 - Passes unanimously

Lambda

- Requested: \$45 for food
- SBA responds:
 - No discussion
- Motion to approve: \$45
 - Passes unanimously

Death Penalty Project

- Requested: \$100 for food
- SBA responds:
 - No discussion
- Motion to approve: \$100
 - Passes unanimously

The Conference on Race, Class, Gender, and Ethnicity

- Requested:
- SBA Responds:
 - We approved 100 for publicity and 399 for movie rights:
 - Did the movie event occur? It happened off campus, however, the movie that was present to the SBA was not screened and they opt'd for a different movie that was cheaper (\$150).
 - This group gets money from student fees
 - Motion to \$189 from \$230 printing
- Motion to approve \$61
 - 2 objections, 1 abstention, 10 in favor
 - Passed

 - Passes unanimously

- Requested:
 - \$100 for food for mixer (retroactive) and meeting
 - \$12 for Honorarium
 - \$6.30 for name tags
- SBA Responds:
 - No discussion
- Motion to \$118.30
 - Passes unanimously

Domestic Violence Action Project

- Requested: \$100 for food for international women's day event in March
- SBA Responds:
 - No discussion
- Motion to \$100
 - Passes unanimously

Immigration Law Association

- Requested: \$ 175 for food and speaker Honorarium
- SBA Responds:
 - Move to strike \$75, since speakers are not confirmed.
- Motion to approve \$100
 - Passes unanimously

American Constitutional Society

- Requested: \$130
 - For pocket constitutions
 - Constitution in the classroom: handouts
- SBA Responds:
 - No discussion
- Motion to approve \$130:
 - 2 abstentions, all others in favor
 - Passed

Women in the Law

- Requested:
 - Women in the public sector – speakers not confirmed
 - The judges Chambers event -speakers not confirmed
 - \$100 for food
- SBA responds:
 - Motion to strike Honorarium and speaker food
- Motion to approve \$100
 - Passes unanimously

Carolina Law Republicans

- Requested: \$100 for banner and \$100 for food
- SBA responds:
 - Last semester SBA approved \$60 for banner
 - Motion to amend banner to \$60
- Motion to approve \$160
 - 2 abstentions, all others in favor
 - Passed

Carolina Intellectual Property Law Association

- Requested:
 - \$100 for food
 - \$75 for honorarium
 - Networking event
 - IP classes at UNC lunch and learn
- SBA Responds:
 - Motion to strike honorarium to 60 because we only give \$10 per professor who is speaking
- Motion to approve \$160
 - Passes unanimously
