 - vi. Amendment to SBA Bylaws
 1. LL.M inclusion on SBA Committees
 2. Renaming the Career Services Committee- changing CSO to CDO because the name changed- **"CAREER DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE** – Shall advise the CDO in their work of assisting law students in securing permanent and summer employment and to work with the CDO office to ensure that student needs are met. This committee shall be composed of no fewer than three (3) students, at least one from each Law School class."
